Art Scheme of Work For Year 1 - Spring Term
An Overview

Plates

In this project children explore decorative designs on plates. They will learn how to make paper mache, to form a plate. They will investigate the designs other artists have used to decorate plates for specific purposes, using this to help them develop their own design to decorate their plate. They will investigate line, colour, pattern and shape to develop their own plate design.

How did Barefoot complement this teaching?

Barefoot Ceramics provided a lesson which included a discussion with the children about how ceramic plates are made, showing them the clay, bisque, paint and final glazed plate. The children then transferred their designs onto a plate using our paints and materials, under the supervision of Barefoot staff. Their work was taken to our studio for firing and returned to the class the following week. Each child had their own handmade plate to take home - ready to eat off!
